CONCEPT NOTE FOR RECRUITMENT OF CAPACITY BUILDING SPECIALIST

Capacity Building has been an integral component of Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) since its inception in 2014. This flagship mission of the Govt of India has always emphasized on inculcating the spirit of *Jan Andolan* among the people in rural areas of the country and sensitize them on maintaining a healthy lifestyle by following safe sanitation and hygiene practices as part of their daily lives.

Under SBM-G Phase II that focuses on achieving ODF Plus villages by 2024-25, capacity building of key stakeholders at the District, Block, GP, Village will be required in order to effectively plan, implement and monitor ODF Plus activities. This would require conducting regular training and capacity strengthening of department level officials, consultants and field functionaries along-with various other concerned stakeholders such as ASHA, Anganwadi workers, SHG members, Youth groups etc. Training will have to provided on various aspects of ODF Plus such as promotion of Social and Behavioural change, Maintenance of IHHL, Inter-department convergence on operation and maintenance of Solid Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) assets etc. Moreover, a Training plan and targeted-oriented framework will also need to be drafted in consonance with the Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) and its execution will need to be overseen both at the state and the district level. Regular monitoring on capacity strengthening initiatives conducted by district coordinators needs to be carried out and their progress has to be supervised, along-with addressing critical gaps related to implementation of the same.

In view of the above, the SBM-G Phase II operational guidelines released by GoI has indicated the need for an Capacity Building Specialist as part of the State SBM-G team (Pg-40). The Capacity Building Specialist (now designated as State Capacity Building Coordinator) will be responsible for successfully plan and implement the Capacity Building strategy for achieving an ODF Plus Assam.

Since this post will be vacant from 1st December, 2022 onwards due to resignation of the currently employed State Capacity Building Coordinator, the recruitment for the same may be conducted by 0/o Mission Directorate, SBM-G Assam.
